

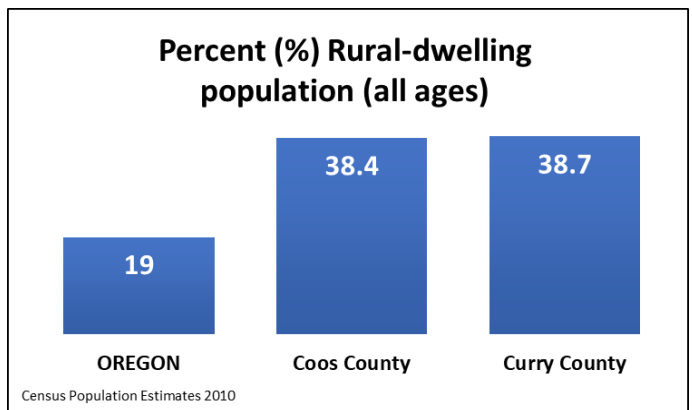
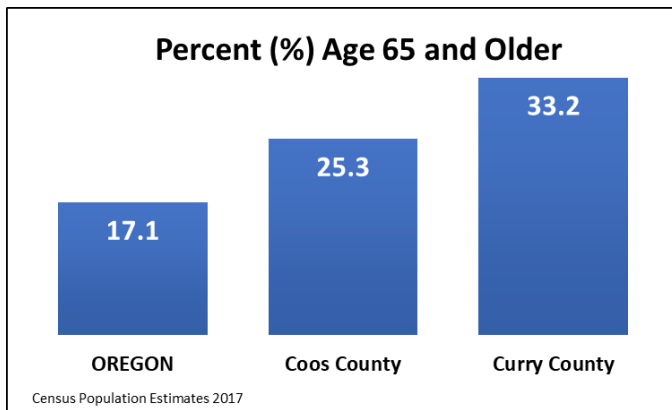
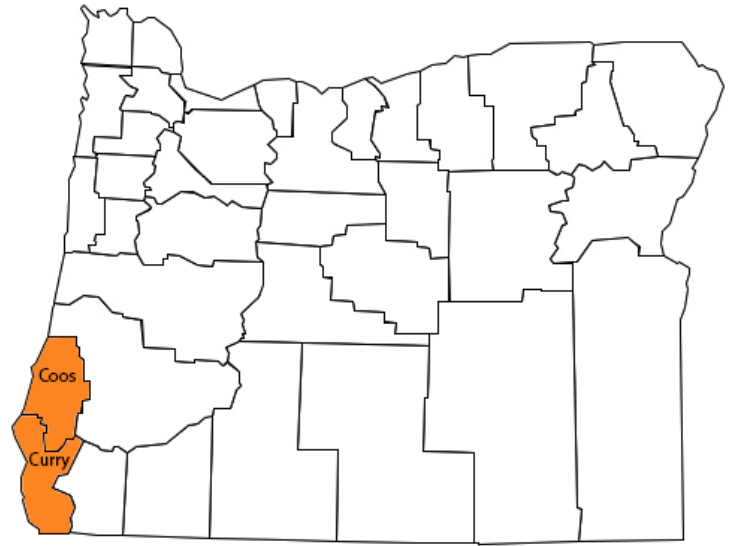
Coos & Curry County Profile

Overview

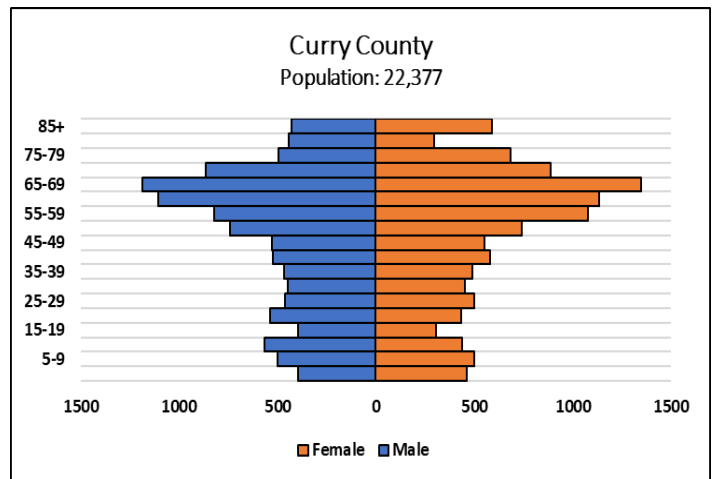
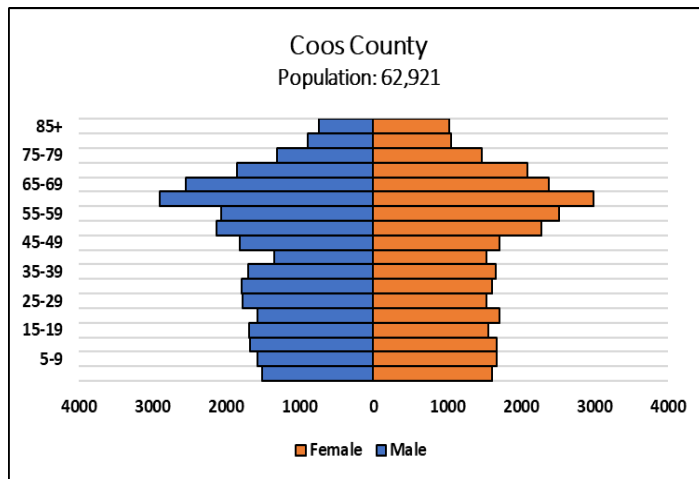
The area encompassing Coos and Curry counties spans approximately 3,794 square miles.

Population

- ✓ Coos County is roughly 3 times the population size of Curry County
- ✓ Coos and Curry counties both have a higher percentage of adults age 65+ compared to Oregon overall
- ✓ Coos and Curry counties have a higher percentage rural-dwelling population compared to Oregon overall
