

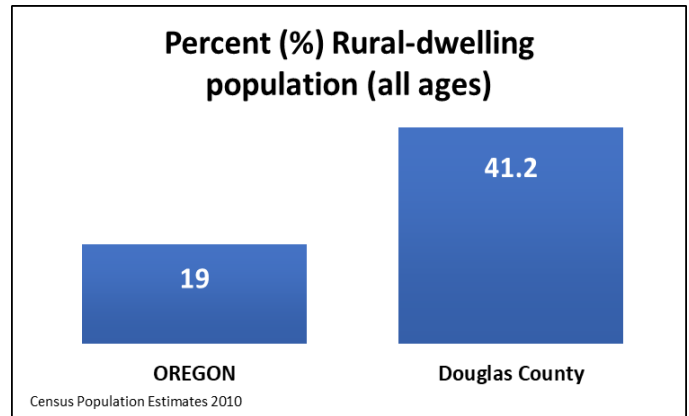
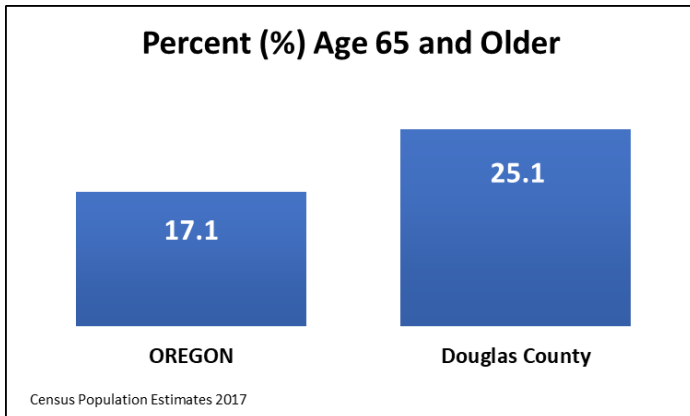
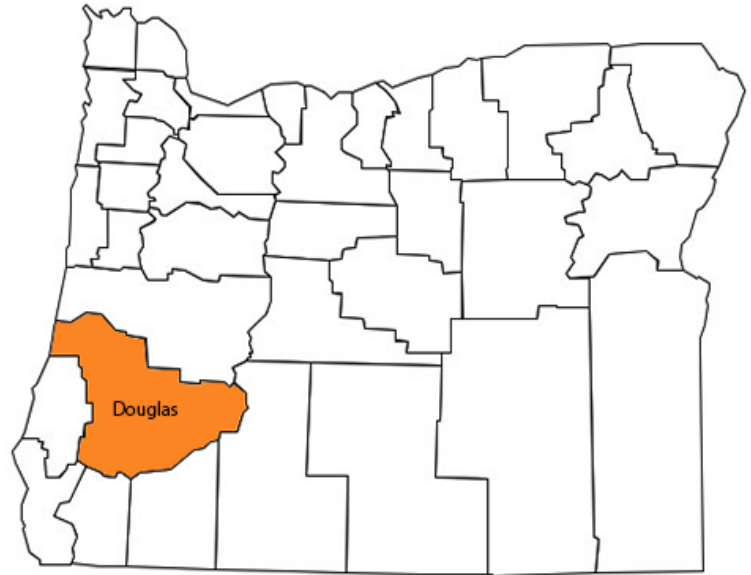
Douglas County Profile

Overview

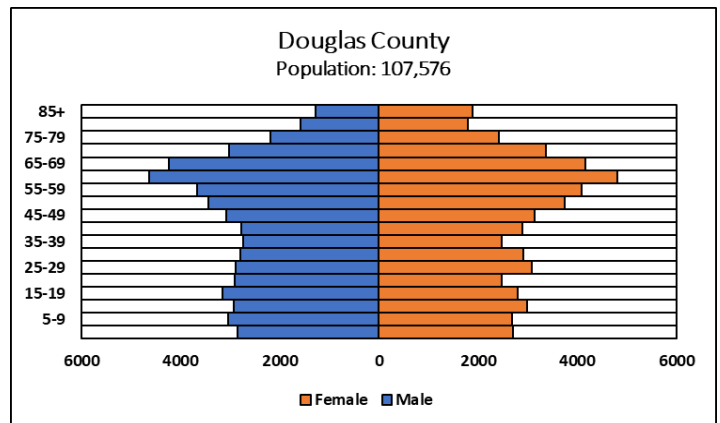
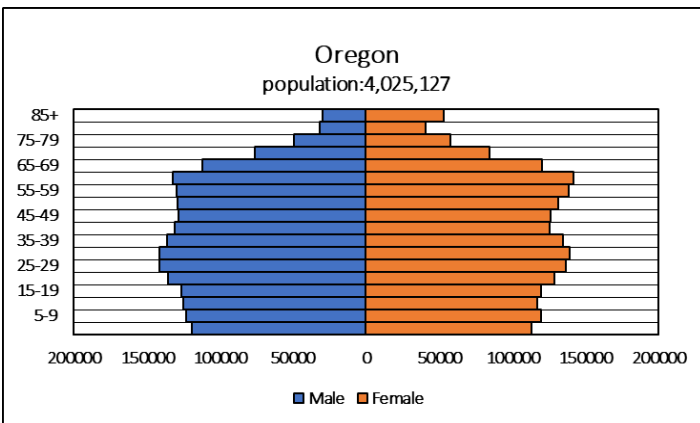
Douglas County spans approximately 5,134 square miles, making it the fifth largest county in terms of area.

- ✓ Douglas County has the ninth largest population size out of all Oregon counties.

- ✓ Douglas County has a higher percentage rural-dwelling population compared to Oregon overall.
