

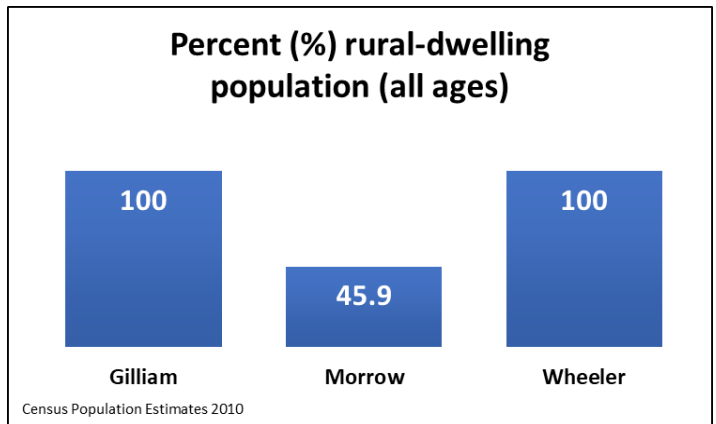
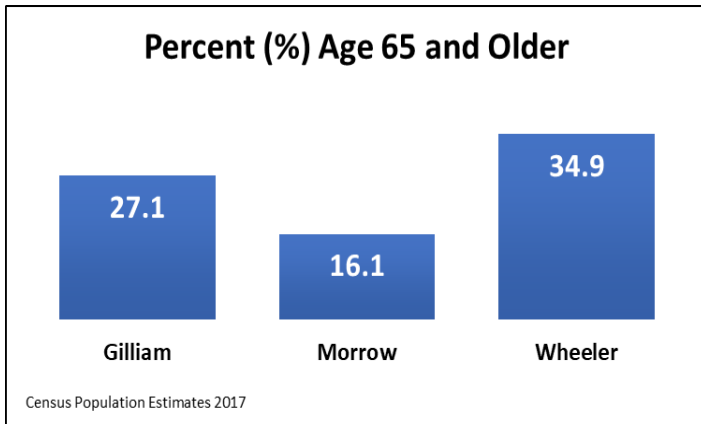
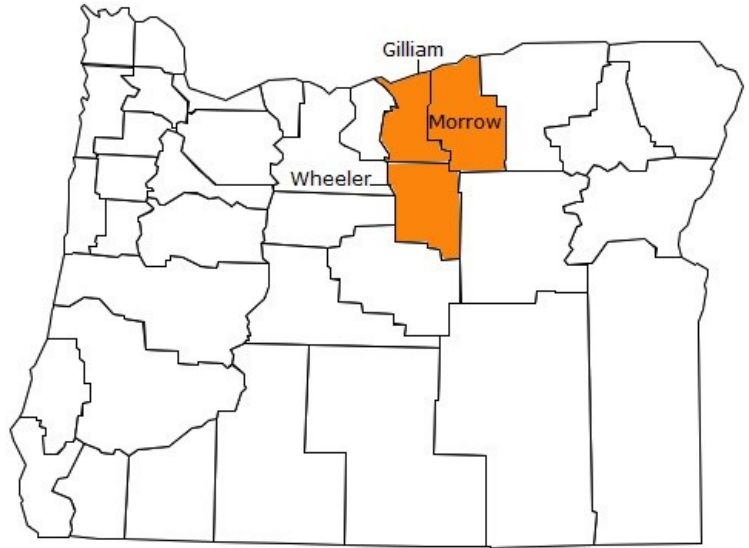
Gilliam, Morrow & Wheeler Counties Profile

Overview

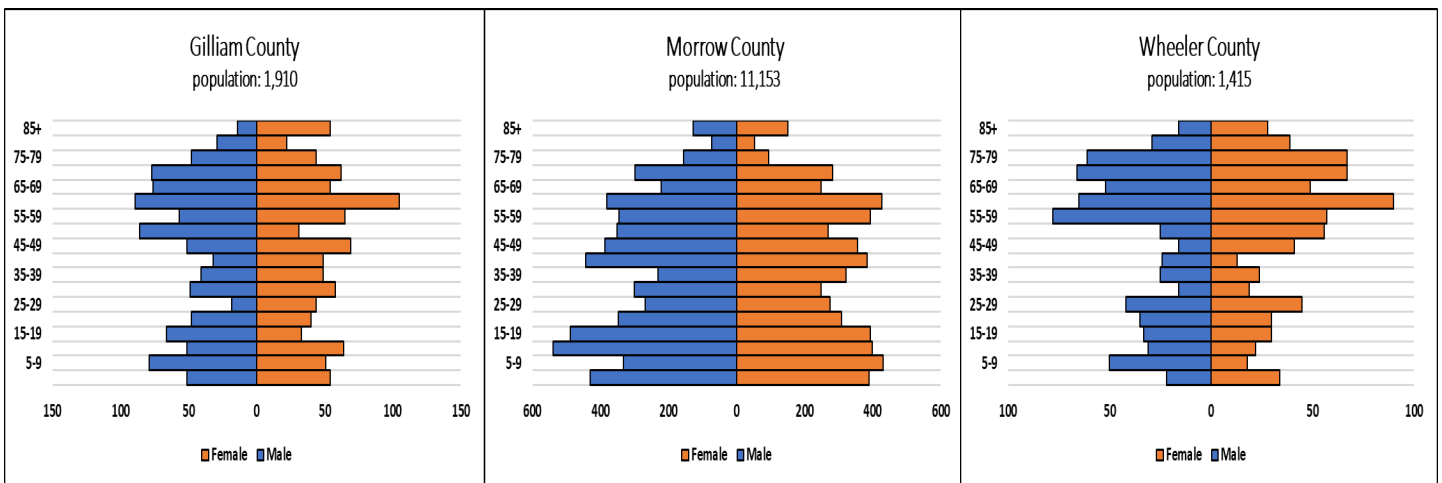
The area encompassing Gilliam, Morrow, and Wheeler counties spans approximately 4,987 square miles.

Population

- ✓ **Wheeler County has the smallest population size out of all Oregon counties.**
- ✓ **Morrow County has the third smallest population size out of all Oregon counties.**
- ✓ **Gilliam and Wheeler counties have entirely rural-dwelling populations.**
