

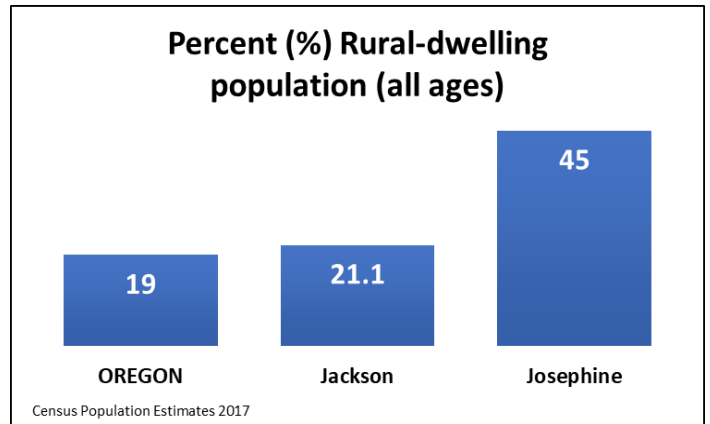
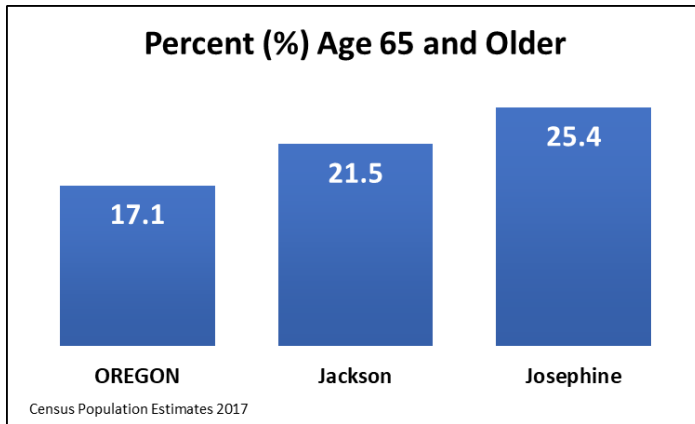
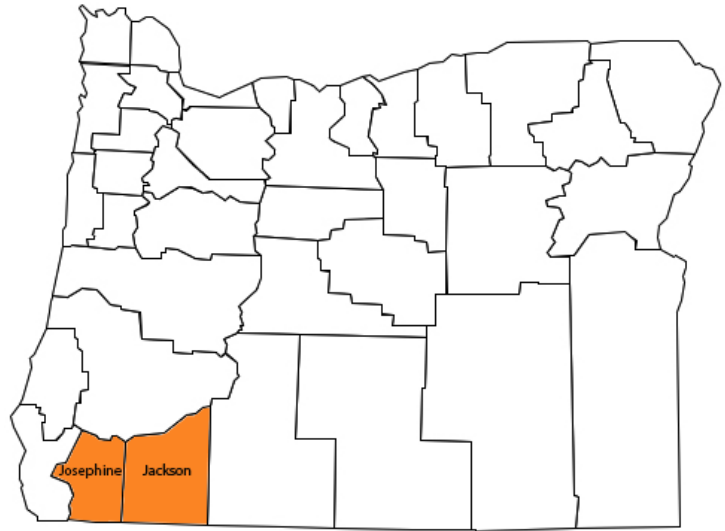
# Jackson & Josephine Counties Profile

## Overview

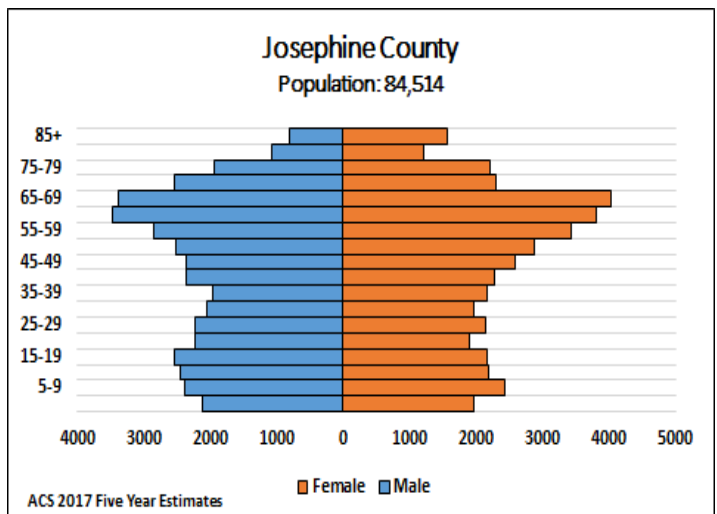
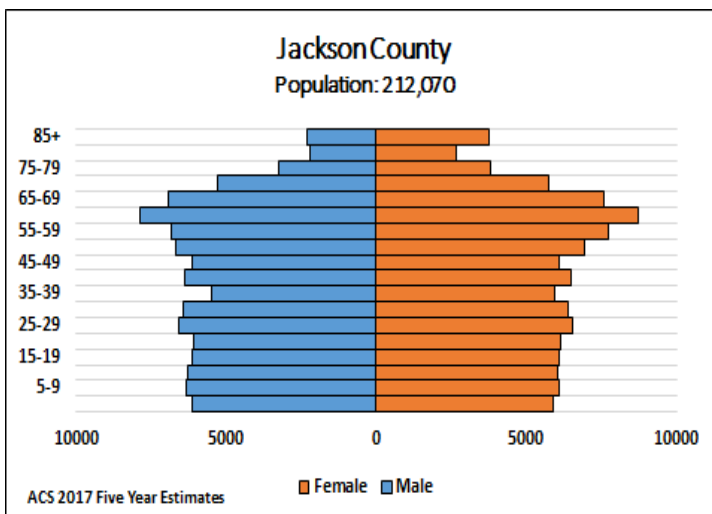
The area encompassing Jackson and Josephine counties spans approximately 4,444 square miles.

## Population

- ✓ Jackson County has the sixth largest population size out of all Oregon counties and is roughly 2.5x larger than Josephine County.
- ✓ Josephine County has a higher rural-dwelling population than both Jackson and Oregon overall.
- ✓ Jackson and Josephine counties have a higher percentage of adults age 65+ compared to Oregon overall.

- ✓ Josephine County has a higher ratio of mental health providers than Jackson and Oregon overall.
- ✓ Both Jackson and Josephine counties have a similar percent prevalence of depression as Oregon overall.
