

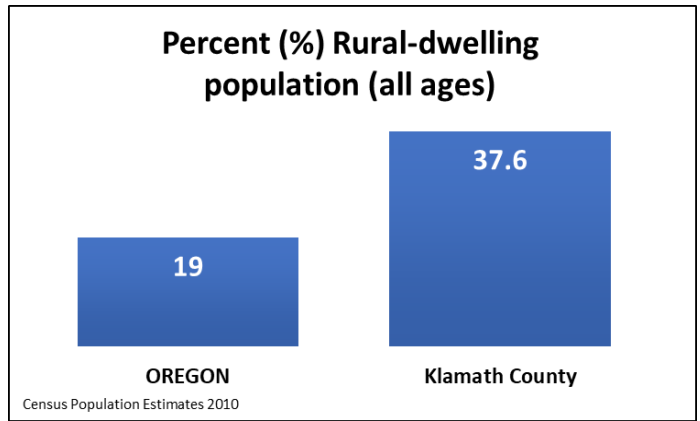
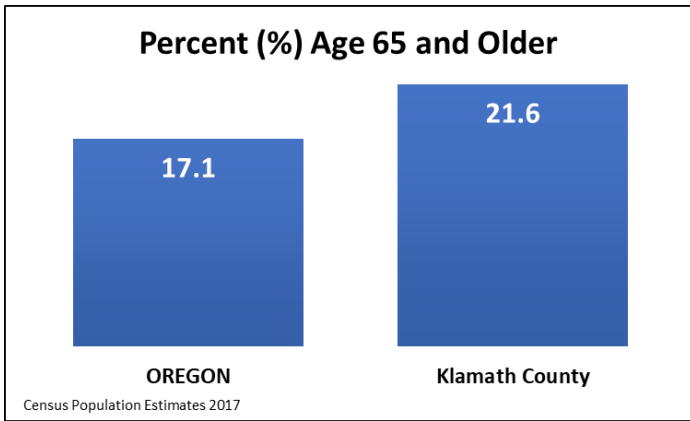
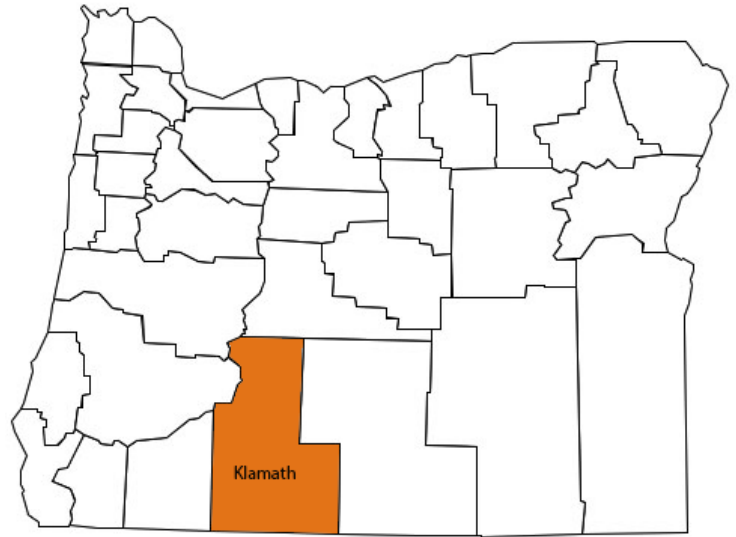
Klamath County Profile

Overview

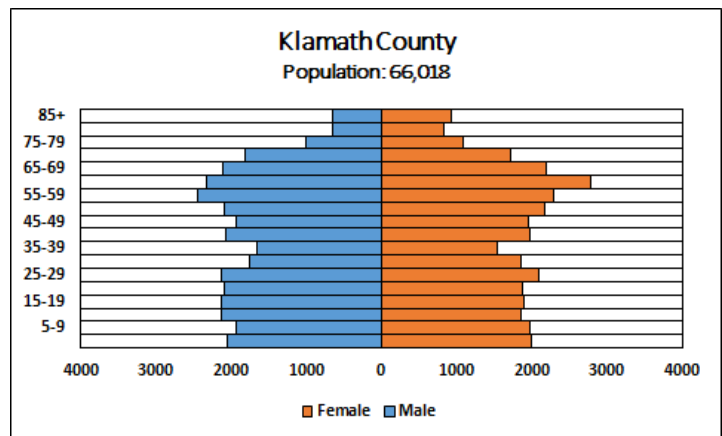
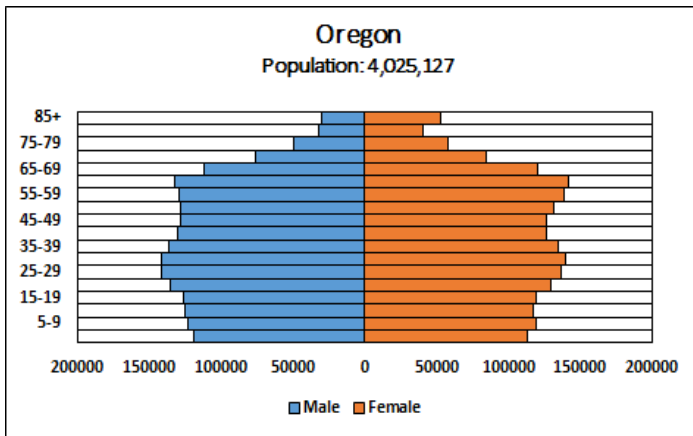
Klamath County spans approximately 6,136 square miles, making it the fourth largest county by area in Oregon.
