

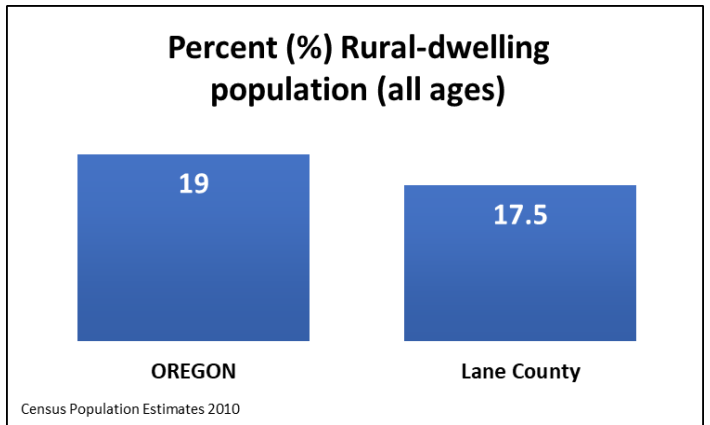
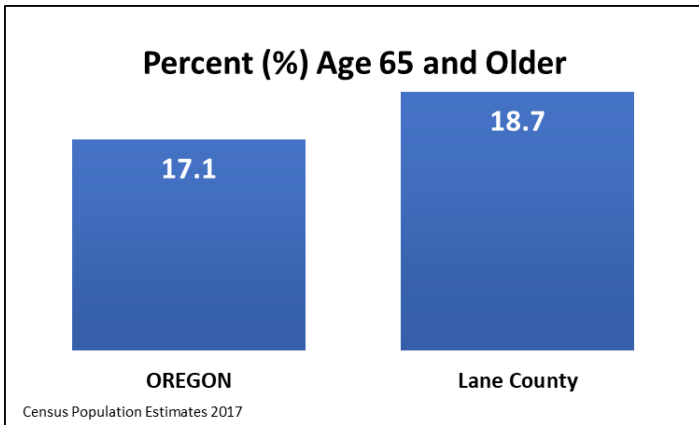
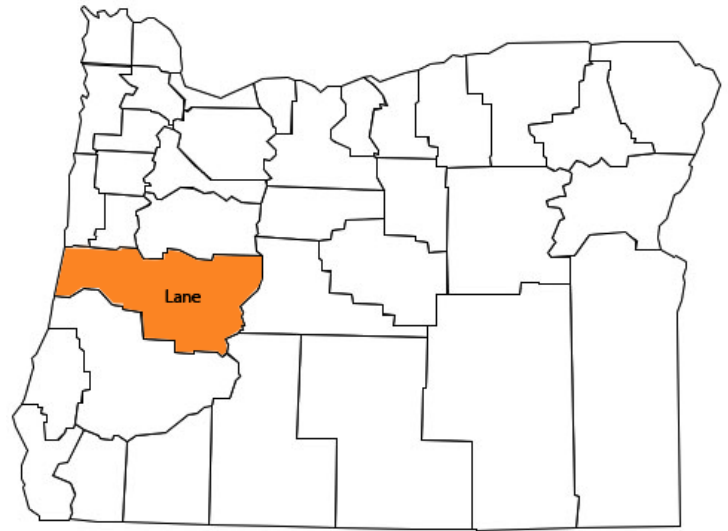
Lane County Profile

Overview

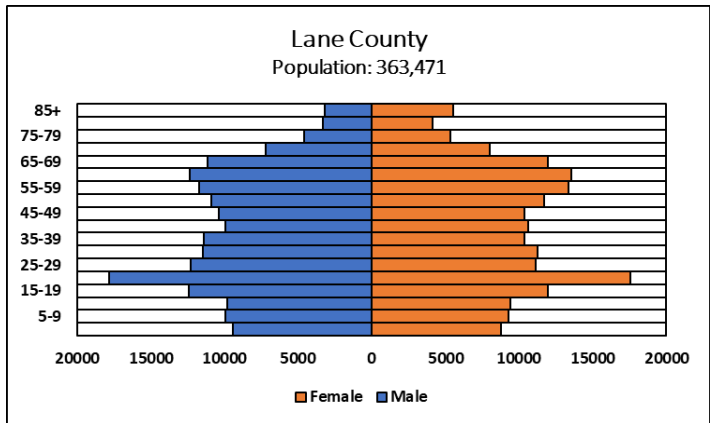
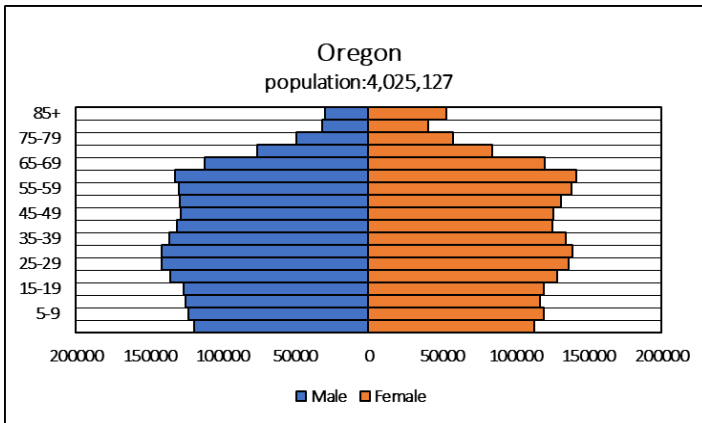
Lane County spans approximately 4,722 square miles, making it the sixth largest county by area in Oregon.
