

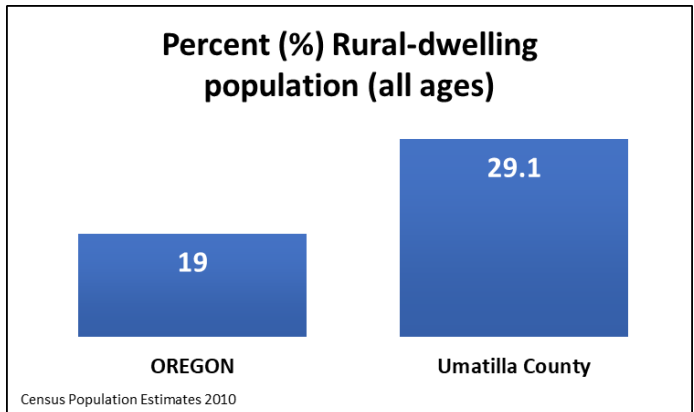
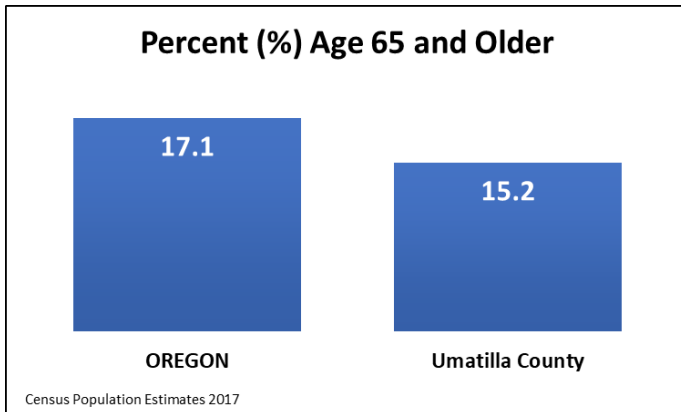
Umatilla County Profile

Overview

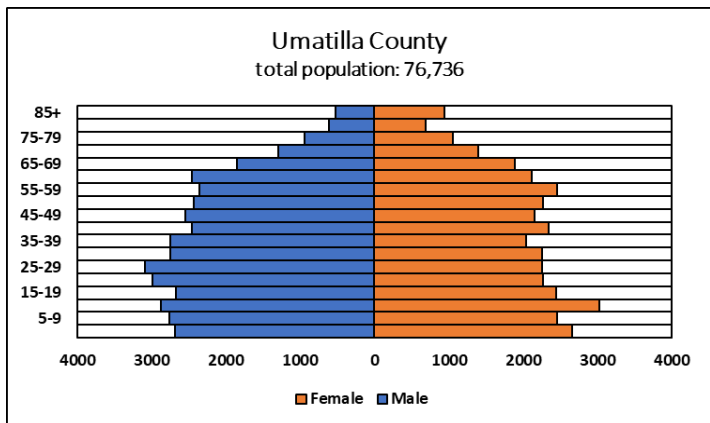
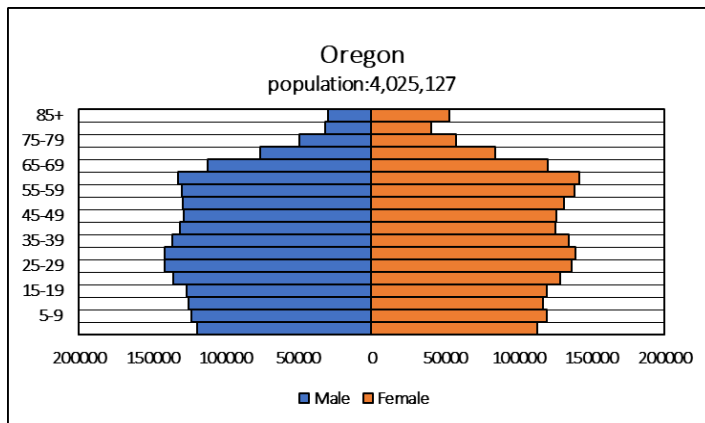
Umatilla County spans approximately 3,231 square miles, making it the eighth largest county by area in Oregon.

Population

- ✓ Umatilla County has a higher percentage rural-dwelling population than Oregon overall.
- ✓ Umatilla County has a slightly lower percentage of adults age 65+ as Oregon overall.
- ✓ Umatilla County has a slightly lower percentage of adults age 65+ living alone compared to Oregon.
